Read twice and referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs.

AN ACT

Providing for a per capita payment of \$100 to each enrolled member of the Chippewa Tribe of Minnesota from the funds standing to their credit in the Treasury of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby,
4 authorized to withdraw from the Treasury of the United
5 States so much as may be necessary of the principal fund on
6 deposit to the credit of the Chippewa Indians in the State
7 of Minnesota, arising under section 7 of the Act of Jan-
8 uary 14, 1889 (Twenty-fifth Statutes at Large, 642),
9 entitled "An Act for the relief and civilization of the
10 Chippewa Indians in the State of Minnesota," and to make
11 therefrom a per capita payment or distribution of \$100 to

1 each enrolled member of the tribe, under such rules and
2 regulations as the said Secretary may prescribe: *Provided*,
3 That before any payment is made hereunder the Chippewa
4 Indians of Minnesota shall, in such manner as may be pre-
5 scribed by the Secretary of the Interior, ratify the provisions
6 of this Act and accept same: *Provided further*, That the
7 money paid to the Indians as authorized herein shall not be
8 subject to any lien or claim of attorneys or other parties.
