Mr. GARNER of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs and ordered to be printed

## A BILL

Providing for a study regarding the equitable use of the waters of the Rio Grande below Fort Quitman, Texas, in cooperation with the United States of Mexico

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the President is hereby authorized to designate three  
4       special commissioners to cooperate with representatives of  
5       the United States of Mexico in a study regarding the  
6       equitable use of the waters of the Rio Grande below Fort  
7       Quitman, Texas, with a view to their proper utilization for  
8       irrigation and other beneficial uses. One of the commis-  
9       sioners so appointed shall be an engineer experienced in such

1 work. Upon completion of such study the results shall be  
2 reported to Congress.

3 SEC. 2. The sum of \$20,000 is hereby authorized to  
4 be appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not  
5 otherwise appropriated for carrying out the provisions hereof.
