AN ACT

To extend for the period of two years the provisions of Title II of the Food Control and the District of Columbia Rents Act, approved October 22, 1919, as amended

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That it is hereby declared that the emergency described
4 in Title II of the Food Control and the District Rents Act
5 still exists and continues in the District of Columbia, and
6 that the present housing and rental conditions therein require
7 the further extension of the provisions of such title.

8 SEC. 2. That Title II of the Food Control and the
9 District of Columbia Rents Act, as amended, is reenacted,

1 extended, and continued, as hereinafter amended, until the
2 22d day of May, 1926, notwithstanding the provisions of
3 section 2 of the Act entitled "An Act to extend for the
4 period of two years the provisions of Title II of the Food
5 Control and the District of Columbia Rents Act," approved
6 October 22, 1919, as amended, approved May 22, 1922.

7 SEC. 3. That subdivision (a) of section 102 of the
8 Food Control and the District of Columbia Rents Act, as
9 amended by section 4 of such Act of May 22, 1922, is
10 hereby amended by striking out the figures "1924" in
11 said subdivision and inserting in lieu thereof the figures
12 "1926".
