Mr. CANNON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Buildings and Grounds and ordered to be printed.

FEBRUARY 28, 1924.

Committed to the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

Authorizing the conveyance to the city of Washington, Missouri, of ten feet of the Federal building site in said city for the extension of the existing public alley through the entire block from Oak to Lafayette Streets.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Treasury be, and he is hereby,
4 authorized to convey to the city of Washington, in the State
5 of Missouri, by quitclaim deed, the north ten feet of the
6 Federal building site in the said city of Washington, Missouri,
7 to be used for an extension of the existing public alley
8 through the entire block from Oak to Lafayette Streets,
9 which said existing public alley now extends but half way
10 through said block, to be used for a public alley and for no

1 other purpose: *Provided, however,* That the city of Wash-
2 ington shall open said extension to the existing public alley
3 as herein authorized to be granted, and improve and main-
4 tain the same as other public alleys of said city are improved
5 and maintained; also, that the city of Washington shall bear
6 all expense incident to the moving of the north curb, and
7 the partial rebuilding of the driveway entrance to the Govern-
8 ment lot, made necessary by the establishment of the new
9 alley line along the northern boundary of the Federal build-
10 ing site: *Provided further,* That the city of Washington
11 shall not have the right to sell or convey the land herein
12 authorized to be granted, or any part thereof, or to devote
13 the same to any other purpose than as hereinbefore described,
14 and in the event that the said land shall not be used for the
15 purpose of a public alley it shall revert to the United States.
