A BILL

To amend an Act entitled "An Act to revive, with amendments, an Act to incorporate the Medical Society of the District of Columbia," approved July 7, 1838, as amended.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Act entitled "An Act to revive with amendments,
4 an Act to incorporate the Medical Society of the District of
5 Columbia," approved July 7, 1838 (Sixth Statutes at Large,
6 page 741), as amended, be, and the same hereby is, amended
7 so as to read as follows:

8 "That Doctors George Wythe Cook, William Gerry
9 Morgan, John B. Nichols, ~~William P. Carr,~~ John D. Thomas,

1 E. Y. Davidson, Philip S. Roy, A. L. Stavely, Henry C.
2 Macatee, E. G. Sibert, J. Russell Verbrycke, junior, A. W.
3 Boswell, Charles S. White, J. A. Gannon, D. S. Lamb,
4 and Virgil B. Jackson, and such other persons as they may
5 associate with themselves, and their successors, be, and they
6 hereby are, constituted a body corporate of the District of
7 Columbia, for the purpose of promoting and disseminating
8 medical and surgical knowledge, and for no other purpose,
9 and not for the purpose of establishing a medical school or
10 schools.

11 "SEC. 2. That the Medical Society of the District of
12 Columbia be, and it is hereby, empowered to own, mortgage,
13 and convey such property as may be necessary for its pur-
14 poses, and to make such rules and regulations as it may
15 require, and which may not be repugnant to the Constitution
16 or laws of the United States.

17 "SEC. 3. That Congress may at any time alter, amend,
18 or ~~annual~~ *amend* this Act of incorporation of said society."
