7 To defray the cost of representation of the United States  
8 at the meeting of the Inter-American Committee on Electri-  
9 cal Communications to be held in Mexico City, Mexico, in  
10 1924, as authorized by the joint resolution approved April  
11 28, 1924, including payment of salaries of a secretary and  
12 other employees, travel and subsistence expenses (notwith-  
13 standing the provisions of any other Act), and such other  
14 expenses as the President may deem necessary to the ac-  
15 complishment of the purposes expressed in the aforesaid  
16 resolution, to be disbursed under the direction and subject to  
17 the approval of the Secretary of State, \$30,000, to remain  
18 available during the fiscal year 1925.

20 MISCELLANEOUS OBJECTS

21 Investigation and prosecution of war frauds: For  
22 the investigation and prosecution of alleged frauds, either  
23 civil or criminal, or other crimes or offenses against the  
24 United States, growing out of or arising in connection with  
25 the preparation for or prosecution of the late war, including

1 the institution and prosecution of suits for the recovery of  
2 moneys which contain no element of fraud but arose incident  
3 to the investigation of alleged frauds, including the same  
4 objects specified under this head in the Act making appro-  
5 priations for the Departments of State and Justice and the  
6 judiciary for the fiscal year 1924, \$200,000, to remain  
7 available until June 30, 1925.

8 UNITED STATES COURTS

9 Salaries, fees, and expenses, United States marshals:  
10 For salaries, fees, and expenses of United States marshals  
11 and their deputies, including the same objects specified under  
12 this head in the Act making appropriations for the Depart-  
13 ments of State and Justice and the judiciary for the fiscal  
14 year 1924, \$530,000.

15 Salaries and expenses of United States district  
16 attorneys: For salaries and expenses of United States district  
17 attorneys, including the same objects specified under this  
18 head in the Act making appropriations for the Departments  
19 of State and Justice and the judiciary for the fiscal year  
20 1924, \$210,000.

21 Salaries and expenses of clerks, United States courts:  
22 For salaries of clerks of United States circuit courts of  
23 appeals and of United States district courts, includ-  
24 ing the same objects specified under this head in the Act  
25 making appropriations for the Departments of State and

1 Justice and for the judiciary for the fiscal year 1924,  
2 \$35,000.

3 Fees of United States commissioners: For fees of  
4 United States commissioners and justices of the peace acting  
5 under section 1014, Revised Statutes of the United States,  
6 \$125,000.

7 Fees of jurors: For fees of jurors, \$250,000.

8 Fees of witnesses: For fees of witnesses and for pay-  
9 ment of the actual expenses of witnesses, as provided by sec-  
10 tion 850, Revised Statutes of the United States, \$200,000.

11 Miscellaneous expenses, United States courts: For such  
12 miscellaneous expenses as may be authorized or approved  
13 by the Attorney General, for the United States courts and  
14 their officers, including so much as may be necessary in the  
15 discretion of the Attorney General for such expenses in the  
16 District of Alaska and in courts other than Federal courts,  
17 \$35,000.

18 PENAL INSTITUTIONS

19 Support of United States prisoners: For support of  
20 United States prisoners, including the same objects specified  
21 under this head in the Act making appropriations for the  
22 Departments of State and Justice and the judiciary for the  
23 fiscal year 1924, \$602,000.
