AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. HARRISON to the bill (H. R. 6820) making appropriations for the Navy Department and the naval service for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925, and for other purposes, viz: On page 51, after line , insert the following as a new paragraph

1 That every officer of the United States Navy or
2 Marine Corps who was dismissed therefrom solely because
3 he left such service in order to join, or did join the Con-
4 federate forces for service during the War between the
5 States shall be held and considered to have duly resigned
6 and to have been honorably discharged therefrom, and the
7 Secretary of the Navy is hereby authorized and directed to
8 correct the records of such officers in accordance herewith,
9 as of the date of their dismissal.
