## AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. BROOKHART to the bill (H. R. 6820) making appropriations for the Navy Department and the naval service for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925, and for other purposes, viz:

1           On page 50, line 25, strike out after the word "plant"  
2 down to and including the word "otherwise" on page 51,  
3 line 7, and insert in lieu thereof the following:

4           "SEC. 2. That all naval vessels, machinery, equip-  
5 ment, and accouterments for such vessels, naval ordnance  
6 and ordnance materials for the Navy, except necessary re-  
7 pairs performed by the enlisted forces while at sea, emer-  
8 gency work performed in a foreign port, necessary re-  
9 pairs to enable a vessel to reach a properly equipped navy

1 yard or other Government owned and operated repair estab-  
2 lishment, and patented articles only so far as the patent  
3 rights extend, shall be constructed, reconditioned, repaired,  
4 manufactured, or produced in the Government navy yards,  
5 arsenals, or other industrial establishments owned and op-  
6 erated by the United States Government, provided that  
7 such Government establishments are equipped to do the  
8 work. In the event any Government establishment has  
9 performed work similar to the work required, such Gov-  
10 ernment establishment shall be considered equipped to do  
11 such work: *Provided*, That no moneys heretofore, herein,  
12 or hereafter appropriated, except to meet obligations or  
13 contracts already let, shall be available for expenditures  
14 made contrary to the provisions of this section."
