A BILL

Authorizing and directing the Secretary of War to transfer to the jurisdiction of the Department of Justice all that portion of the Fort Leavenworth Military Reservation which lies in the State of Missouri, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of War is hereby authorized and directed
4 to transfer to the jurisdiction of the Department of Justice for
5 use as a farm in connection with the United States peniten-
6 tiary, Leavenworth, Kansas, all of that portion of the Fort
7 Leavenworth Military Reservation which lies in the State

1 of Missouri, and including the bridge across the Missouri
2 River. And \$50,000 of the appropriation for roads, walks,
3 wharves, and drainage contained in the War Department
4 Appropriation Act for the fiscal year 1924, which was ap-
5 propriated for the repair of said bridge, shall be transferred
6 to the Department of Justice for use in making necessary
7 repairs to said bridge and the approaches thereto.
