AN ACT

Authorizing preliminary examinations and surveys of sundry streams with a view to the control of their floods

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of War be, and he is hereby, authorized
4 and directed to cause preliminary examinations to be made
5 of the following streams with a view to the control of their
6 floods in accordance with the provisions of section 3 of "An
7 Act to provide for the control of the floods of the Mississippi
8 River and of the Sacramento River, California, and for other
9 purposes," approved March 1, 1917:

10 Trinity River, Texas; Brazos River, Texas; Canadian
11 River, New Mexico, Texas, and Oklahoma; North Fork
12 Canadian, Texas and Oklahoma; Deep Fork, Verdigris, and

1 Little River, Oklahoma; Cimarron River, New Mexico and
2 Oklahoma; Wolf and Fox Rivers, Wisconsin; West Fork
3 of White River, Indiana; Guadalupe River, Texas; Colum-
4 bia River, between Martins Bluff and mouth of Lewis
5 River, Washington; Skagit River, Washington; Pond River,
6 Kentucky; Colorado River, Texas; Red River, Arkansas.

7 The sum of \$4,700, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is hereby authorized to be expended out of any
9 funds heretofore appropriated for examinations, surveys,
10 and contingencies of rivers and harbors to carry out the
11 provisions of this section.

12 SEC. 2. That the Secretary of War is hereby author-
13 ized and directed to cause surveys to be made of the follow-
14 ing streams with a view to the control of their floods in
15 accordance with the provisions of section 3 of "An Act to
16 provide for the control of the floods of the Mississippi River
17 and of the Sacramento River, California, and for other pur-
18 poses," approved March 1, 1917:

19 North Branch of the Susquehanna River, Pennsylvania
20 and New York, and the sum of \$8,000 is hereby authorized
21 to be appropriated for this purpose.

22 Allegheny and Monongahela Rivers, and the sum of
23 \$25,000 is hereby authorized to be appropriated for this
24 purpose: *Provided*, That no money hereby authorized to be
25 appropriated shall be expended unless and until assurances

1 have been given satisfactory to the Secretary of War that
 2 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will contribute a like
 3 sum of \$25,000 for the purpose of making the survey hereby
 4 authorized; and the Secretary of War is hereby authorized
 5 to receive from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania such
 6 sum of \$25,000 and to expend the same as the \$25,000
 7 hereby authorized to be appropriated may be expended.
