A BILL

To make a preliminary survey of Red River in Arkansas, south of Fulton, with a view to control of its floods.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of War be, and he is hereby, authorized
4 and directed to cause a preliminary survey to be made of
5 the Red River in Arkansas, south of Fulton, with a view
6 to control of its floods, in accordance with provisions of an
7 Act entitled "An Act to provide for the control of the
8 floods of the Mississippi River and the Sacramento River,
9 California, and for other purposes," approved March 1,
10 1917.
