Mr. MANSFIELD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Flood Control and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

Authorizing and directing the Secretary of War to cause survey to be made of the Guadalupe River in Texas, with a view to the removal of the raft and to controlling the flood waters of said stream, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That the Secretary of War be, and he is hereby, authorized
- 4 and directed to cause a survey to be made of the Guadalupe
- 5 River, in the State of Texas, with a view to the removal of
- 6 the raft and to controlling the flood waters of said stream,
- 7 in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Congress
- 8 approved March 1, 1917, known as the Flood Control Act.
