**A BILL**

To make a preliminary survey of the Cimarron River of New Mexico and Oklahoma with a view to the control of floods.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the Secretary of War be, and he is hereby, authorized  
4        and directed to cause a preliminary survey to be made of  
5        the Cimarron River of New Mexico and Oklahoma with a  
6        view to the control of floods, in accordance with provisions  
7        of an Act entitled "An Act to provide for the control of  
8        the floods of the Mississippi River and the Sacramento  
9        River, California, and for other purposes," approved March  
10       1, 1917.
