Mr. BROWN of Wisconsin introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Flood Control and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

Providing for a preliminary survey of the Wolf River in Wisconsin to ascertain some method to control floods.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of War is hereby authorized and di-
4 rected to cause preliminary examinations and surveys to be
5 made of the Wolf River for the purpose of ascertaining some
6 practical method to control flood conditions with special
7 reference to the navigation of the waters of the Winnebago
8 Pool, and with reference to the effect of such control and re-
9 lief upon developed water power, such survey to include
10 what is known as the Shiocton plan of diverting flood waters

1 from the Wolf River to Green Bay. That there is hereby
 2 appropriated for such purpose such sum as is necessary to
 3 make such investigation and survey not exceeding, however,
 4 the sum of \$25,000.
