Mr. MANSFIELD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Flood Control and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

Authorizing and directing the Secretary of War to cause survey to be made of the Colorado River in Texas, with a view to the removal of the raft in said stream in the counties of Wharton and Matagorda, and to controlling the flood waters of said stream, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of War be, and he is hereby, authorized
4 and directed to cause a survey to be made of the Colorado
5 River, in the State of Texas, with a view to the removal
6 of the raft in said stream in the counties of Wharton and
7 Matagorda, and to controlling the flood waters of said stream,
8 in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Congress
9 approved March 1, 1917, known as the Flood Control Act.
