A BILL

Providing for a survey of the West Fork of White River, Indiana, with a view to making same navigable.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of War is hereby authorized and directed
4 to cause a survey to be made of the West Fork of White
5 River, Indiana, from its mouth to the city of Martinsville,
6 Indiana, with a view of securing increased depth and width
7 in the channel; also with the further view of straightening
8 the channel where advisable with a view of controlling
9 flood waters.
