Mr. KNUTSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

Authorizing payment to certain Red Lake Indians, out of Chippewa Indian funds, for garden plats surrendered for school-farm use.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That the Secretary of the Interior is hereby authorized to
- 4 withdraw from the Treasury of the United States not to
- 5 exceed \$1,000, out of moneys on deposit to the credit of the
- 6 Red Lake Indians in Minnesota, and to use the same, or as
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary, in reimbursing certain
- 8 Red Lake Indians whom he may find to have suffered loss
- 9 through the taking of their individual garden plats, without
- 10 remuneration to them, for Indian school-farm purposes.
