

IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

JANUARY 3, 1924.

Mr. WINTER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

To amend section 115 of the Act of March 3, 1911, entitled  
"An Act to codify, revise, and amend the laws relating to  
the judiciary."

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That section 115 of the Act approved March 3, 1911,  
4       entitled "An Act to codify, revise, and amend the laws re-  
5       *lating to the judiciary," be, and the same is hereby, amended*  
6       so as to read as follows:

7       "SEC. 115. The State of Wyoming and the Yellow-  
8       stone National Park shall constitute one judicial district, to  
9       be known as the district of Wyoming. Terms of the dis-  
10      trict court for said district shall be held at Cheyenne on the  
11      second Mondays in May and November, at Casper on the  
12      first Monday in February, at Evanston on the second Tues-  
13      day in July, and at Lander on the first Monday in October;

1 and the said court shall hold one session annually at Sheri-  
2 dan, and in said national park, on such dates as the court  
3 may order. The marshal and clerk of the said court shall  
4 each, respectively, appoint at least one deputy to reside at  
5 Casper, and one to reside at Evanston, and one to reside at  
6 Lander, and shall also maintain an office at each of those  
7 places: *Provided*, That, until a public building is provided at  
8 Casper, suitable accommodations for holding court in said  
9 town shall be furnished the Government at an expense not  
10 to exceed \$300 annually. The marshal of the United States  
11 for the said district may appoint one or more deputy mar-  
12 shals for the Yellowstone National Park, who shall reside in  
13 said park.”
