AN ACT

To repeal the first proviso of section 4 of an Act to establish a national park in the Territory of Hawaii, approved August 1, 1916.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 That the first proviso of section 4 of an Act entitled "An
4 Act to establish a national park in the Territory of Hawaii,"
5 approved August 1, 1916, which is in words and figures
6 following: "*Provided, That no appropriation for the main-*
7 *tenance, supervision, and improvement of said park in excess*
8 *of \$10,000 annually shall be made unless the same shall*
9 *have first been expressly authorized by law," be, and the*
10 same is hereby, repealed.
