DECEMBER 6, 1923.

Mr. JONES of Washington introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A BILL

To extend the time for the completion of the construction of a bridge across the Columbia River between the States of Oregon and Washington at or within two miles westerly from Cascade Locks in the State of Oregon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the time for the completion of the construction of a
4 bridge and approaches thereto across the Columbia River at
5 a point suitable to the interests of navigation at or near a
6 point within two miles westerly from Cascade Locks, in the
7 county of Hood River, State of Oregon, authorized by the
8 Act of Congress approved February 3, 1920, is hereby ex-
9 tended to February 15, 1926.

10 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
11 Act is hereby expressly reserved,
