Mr. SNELL, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into
3 the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the
4 Union for the consideration of the bill H. R. 5478, to amend
5 sections 1, 3, and 6 of an Act entitled "An Act to provide
6 for the promotion of vocational rehabilitation of persons dis-
7 abled in industry, or otherwise, and their return to civil em-
8 ployment." That after general debate, which shall be con-
9 fined to the bill, and shall continue not to exceed one hour,
10 to be equally divided and controlled by those favoring and
11 opposing the bill, the bill shall be read for amendment
12 under the five-minute rule. At the conclusion of the
13 reading of the bill for amendment the committee shall rise
14 and report the bill to the House with such amendments as

1 may have been adopted, and the previous question shall be
2 considered on the bill and the amendments thereto to final
3 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
4 recommit.
