AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. FLETCHER to the bill (H. R. 7220), making appropriations for the Department of Agriculture for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925, and for other purposes, viz: On page 37, after line 2, insert the following:

1 That the sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, be, and the same is hereby, appropriated, out
3 of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
4 for expenditure during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1924,
5 by the Secretary of Agriculture in the establishment and
6 maintenance of a forest experiment station at such suitable
7 place in the southern pine region of the United States as the
8 Secretary of Agriculture may determine, including the

1 erection of buildings and all other necessary expenses, for
2 the purpose of conducting silvicultural, dendrological, and
3 other experiments and investigations independently or in
4 cooperation with other branches of the Federal Government,
5 with States, and with individuals, to determine the best
6 methods for the conservative management of forests and
7 forest lands and the production of timber, naval stores, and
8 other forest products, in the southern pine region of the
9 United States: *Provided*, That the cost of any building
10 erected at said station may amount to but shall not exceed
11 \$2,500: *Provided further*, That the Secretary of Agri-
12 culture is hereby authorized, in his discretion, to accept
13 donations of lands in the southern pine region for forest
14 investigations and the use of said experiment station.
