**AN ACT**

To pay tuition of Indian children in public schools.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That the Secretary of the Interior is hereby authorized to  
4 pay any claims which are ascertained to be proper and just,  
5 whether covered by contracts or not, for tuition of Indian  
6 pupils in State public schools during the fiscal years 1922  
7 and 1923, and to expend for such purpose out of balances  
8 remaining from the appropriations for support of Indian  
9 day and industrial schools for such fiscal years, not to exceed  
10 a total of \$30,000, without regard to the limitations hereto-  
11 fore placed by law upon the use of such appropriations for  
12 tuition of Indian pupils in public schools *pupils in State*  
13 *public schools during the fiscal years 1921, 1922, and 1923,*

1 and to expend for such purpose whatever balances may  
2 remain from the appropriations for support of Indian day  
3 and industrial schools for such fiscal years, respectively,  
4 without regard to the limitations heretofore placed by law  
5 upon the use of such appropriations for tuition of Indian  
6 pupils in public schools: Provided, That so much as may be  
7 necessary of the unexpended balance of the appropriation  
8 for the fiscal year 1921 as may be required for the foregoing  
9 purpose is hereby appropriated.
