Mr. LEAVITT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

To pay tuition of Indian children in public schools.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Interior is hereby authorized to
4 pay any claims which are ascertained to be proper and just,
5 whether covered by contracts or not, for tuition of Indian
6 pupils in State public schools during the fiscal years 1921,
7 1922, and 1923, and to expend for such purpose whatever
8 balances may remain from the appropriations for support
9 of Indian day and industrial schools for such fiscal years,
10 respectively, without regard to the limitations heretofore
11 placed by law upon the use of such appropriations for tuition
12 of Indian pupils in public schools: *Provided*, That so much
13 as may be necessary of the unexpended balance of the ap-
14 propriation for the fiscal year 1921, as may be required for
15 the foregoing purpose, is hereby reappropriated.
