Mr. JOHNSON of Washington introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Public Lands and ordered to be printed

Committed to the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union and ordered to be printed

A BILL

To authorize an exchange of lands with the State of Washington.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That upon delivery to the Secretary of the Interior by the
4 State of Washington of its properly executed conveyance to
5 the United States of America in fee simple of the following
6 lands in that State: The northwest quarter of the northeast
7 quarter, the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter,
8 the south half of the northwest quarter, the south-
9 west quarter and the northwest quarter of the southeast
10 quarter, all in section 16, township 20 north, range 1 east,

1 Willamette Meridian, containing three hundred and sixty
2 acres, the Secretary of the Interior is authorized to issue in
3 exchange therefor a patent to the State of Washington to the
4 following lands in that State: The north half of the north-
5 west quarter, the east half of the southwest quarter of the
6 northwest quarter, the east half of the northwest quarter of
7 the southwest quarter, all in section 25, township 22 north,
8 range 10 west, Willamette Meridian.

9 SEC. 2. That the lands first described shall as soon as
10 title thereto is vested in the United States be under the care
11 and control of the Attorney General of the United States,
12 to be administered by him as a part of the Federal peni-
13 tentiary on McNeil Island.
