AMENDMENT

Intended to be proposed by Mr. HARRISON to the bill (H. R. 5325) conferring jurisdiction upon the Court of Claims to hear, examine, consider, and adjudicate claims which the Choctaw and Chickasaw Indians may have against the United States, and for other purposes, viz:

1 At the end of section 3, on page 3, insert the following
2 additional section:

3 “ That the Mississippi Choctaws whose names do not
4 appear upon the tribal rolls of the Choctaw Nation, but who
5 would have been entitled to enrollment under the laws re-
6 lating to the final enrollment of the citizens of the Choctaw-
7 Chickasaw Nations if they had made application and other-
8 wise complied with the provisions of the Act of Congress

1 . pertaining thereto, may file their petition, or petitions, in
2 said Court of Claims, which is hereby given power and au-
3 ~~thority to hear and adjudicate any claim of said Mississippi~~
4 Choctaws against the United States, or against the Choctaw
5 or Chickasaw Nations, provided that said claimants under
6 this section shall proceed under all of the provisions and
7 restrictions of the other sections of this Act, but in the
8 event they have no sufficient tribal organization, they may
9 proceed through a committee or as individuals.”
