## **AN ACT**

To extend the insurance and collect-on-delivery service to third-class mail, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the requirement of section 8 of the Act of August 24,  
4        1912, making appropriations for the service of the Post  
5        Office Department for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1913,  
6        and for other purposes (Thirty-seventh Statutes at Large,  
7        pages 557, 558, and 559), applicable to fourth-class (parcel  
8        post) mail: "That the Postmaster General shall make pro-  
9        vision by regulation for the indemnification of shippers for  
10       shipment injured or lost, by insurance or otherwise, and

1 when desired for the collection on delivery of the postage  
2 and price of the article shipped, fixing such charges as may  
3 be necessary to pay the cost of such additional service." is  
4 hereby extended to cover third-class domestic mail.
