AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the Great Northern Railway Company, a corporation, to maintain and operate or reconstruct, maintain, and operate a bridge across the Mississippi River.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of the Congress is hereby granted to the
4 Great Northern Railway Company, a corporation organized
5 under the laws of the State of Minnesota, its successors and
6 assigns, to maintain and operate or reconstruct, maintain,
7 and operate an existing bridge and approaches thereto
8 across the Mississippi River at Nicollet Island in the vicinity
9 of Second Avenue, within the city of Minneapolis, State of
10 Minnesota, in accordance with the provisions of an Act

1 entitled "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges
2 over navigable waters," approved March 23, 1906.

3 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
4 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
