A BILL

Granting the consent of Congress to the Great Northern Railway Company, a corporation, to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge across the Mississippi River.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of the Congress is hereby granted to the
4 Great Northern Railway Company, a corporation organized
5 under the laws of the State of Minnesota, its successors and
6 assigns, to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge and ap-
7 proaches thereto across the Mississippi River within the city
8 of Minneapolis, State of Minnesota, in accordance with the
9 provisions of an Act entitled "An Act to regulate the con-
10 struction of bridges over navigable waters," approved March
11 23, 1906.

12 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
13 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
