MR. SUTHERLAND introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Territories and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

To amend an Act entitled "An Act to authorize the incorporated town of Ketchikan, Alaska, to issue its bonds in any sum not to exceed \$100,000 for the purpose of constructing a schoolhouse in said town and equipping the same," approved February 7, 1920.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 1 of the Act entitled "An Act to authorize the
4 incorporated town of Ketchikan, Alaska, to issue bonds in
5 any sum not exceeding \$100,000 for the purpose of con-
6 structing a schoolhouse in said town and equipping the
7 same," be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as fol-
8 lows:

1 “SECTION 1. That the incorporated town of Ketchikan,
2 Alaska, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds
3 in any sum not exceeding \$150,000 for the purpose of con-
4 structing schoolhouses in said town and equipping the
5 same.”
