AN ACT

Authorizing the Secretary of War to sell a portion of the Carlisle Barracks Reservation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the transfer from the Department of the Interior to the
4 War Department of the control and jurisdiction over the
5 parcels known as farm numbered 1, farm numbered 2, and
6 the Sanno tract, now constituting a part of the Govern-
7 ment reservation at Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania, is rat-
8 ified and confirmed.

9 SEC. 2. The Secretary of War is authorized to sell
10 at public sale, upon terms and conditions deemed advisable
11 by him, the land lying north of the Carlisle-Harrisburg High-

1 way, being part of the tract of land known as farm numbered
2 2, constituting a part of the Carlisle Barracks Reservation,
3 the land to be sold as a whole or in parcels as the Secretary
4 of War may determine, and to execute and deliver in the
5 name of the United States and in its behalf any and all deeds
6 or other instruments necessary to effect such sale.

7 SEC. 3. The Secretary of War is authorized to acquire
8 by negotiation or appropriate condemnation proceedings ad-
9 ditional land needed at the post of Carlisle Barracks for the
10 use of the Medical Field Service School, to wit: The so-called
11 Alexander tract, being a triangular parcel of ground lying
12 to the southeastward of the original reservation and between
13 said original reservation, the said farm numbered 1, and the
14 Cumberland Valley Railway, comprising nineteen and six-
15 tenths acres, more or less; and the so-called Henderson tract,
16 being an irregular parcel of ground lying northwestward
17 of the original reservation and the said farm numbered 1,
18 and southeastward of the Carlisle-Harrisburg Highway,
19 comprising thirty-four acres, more or less: *Provided*, That
20 the proceeds realized from the sale authorized by section 2 of
21 this Act of the part of farm numbered 2 therein described
22 may be applied toward the acquisition of the said Alexander
23 and Henderson tracts: *And provided further*, That any resi-
24 due of the proceeds of the said sale not required to pay for
25 the acquisition of the said tracts under the provisions of this

1 Act shall be deposited in the Treasury as miscellaneous
2 receipts.
