Mr. KAHN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Military Affairs and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

Authorizing the Secretary of War to sell a portion of the Carlisle Barracks Reservation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the transfer from the Department of the Interior to the
4 War Department of the control and jurisdiction over the
5 parcels known as farm numbered 1, farm numbered 2, and
6 the Sanno tract, now constituting a part of the Govern-
7 ment reservation at Carlisle Barracks, Pennsylvania, is rat-
8 ified and confirmed.

9 SEC. 2. The Secretary of War is authorized to sell
10 at either public or private sale, upon terms and condi-
11 tions deemed advisable by him, the land lying north of the

1 Carlisle-Harrisburg Highway, being part of the tract of land
2 known as farm numbered 2, constituting a part of the Car-
3 lisle Barracks Reservation, the land to be sold as a whole or in
4 parcels as the Secretary of War may determine, and to exe-
5 cute and deliver in the name of the United States and in its
6 behalf any and all deeds or other instruments necessary to
7 effect such sale.

8 SEC. 3. For the acquisition of the additional land
9 needed at the post of Carlisle Barracks for the use of the
10 medical field service school an appropriation of \$10,000 is
11 authorized.
