Mr. FULLER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

To authorize the State of Illinois to construct, maintain, and operate two bridges, and approaches thereto, across the Fox River in the county of Kendall and State of Illinois.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the State of Illinois be, and is hereby, authorized to
4 construct, maintain, and operate two bridges, and approaches
5 thereto, across the Fox River, in the county of Kendall, and
6 State of Illinois, on the spur of State Road numbered 18,
7 connecting the villages of Yorkville and Bristol in said
8 county of Kendall, to replace bridges now connecting the
9 said villages of Yorkville and Bristol, in accordance with
10 the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the

1 construction of bridges over navigable waters," approved
2 March 23, 1906.

3 SEC. 2. The right to alter, amend, or repeal this Act is
4 hereby expressly reserved.
