## AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the construction of a bridge  
across the Rio Grande

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to C. M.  
4 Newman, his successors and assigns, to construct, maintain,  
5 and operate a bridge, and approaches thereto, across the  
6 Rio Grande, at a point suitable to the interests of naviga-  
7 tion, at or near the point known as Alamo Alto, on the  
8 American side of the river, one thousand seven hundred and  
9 fifty feet northwest from the El Paso and ~~Mad~~speth County  
10 line, in survey numbered 51, El Paso County, Texas, in ac-  
11 cordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to  
12 regulate the construction of bridges over navigable waters,"

1 approved March 23, 1906, such construction to be made  
2 only with the consent and approval of the Republic of  
3 Mexico.

4 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this  
5 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
