A BILL

Granting the consent of Congress to the construction of a bridge
across the Rio Grande

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to C. M.
4 Newman, his successors and assigns, to construct, maintain,
5 and operate a steel vehicular and foot bridge, and approaches
6 thereto, across the Rio Grande, at a point suitable to the
7 interests of navigation, at or near the point known as Alamo
8 Alto, on the American side of the river, one thousand seven
9 hundred and fifty feet northwest from the El Paso and
10 Hudspeth County line, in survey numbered 51, El Paso
11 County, Texas, in accordance with the provisions of the

1 Act entitled "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges
2 over navigable waters," approved March 23, 1906, such
3 construction to be made only with the consent and approval
4 of the Republic of Mexico.

5 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
6 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
