Mr. LANKFORD introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce and ordered to be printed

A BILL

Granting the consent of Congress to the States of Georgia and Florida, through their respective highway departments, to construct a bridge across the Saint Marys River

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the States
4 of Georgia and Florida, through their respective highway
5 departments, and their successors and assigns, to construct,
6 maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches thereto
7 across the Saint Marys River, at a point suitable to the in-
8 terests of navigation, at or near Saint Marys, Camden
9 County, Georgia, known as the "Borrell Tract," and to

1 the shore opposite thereto, known as "Roses Bluff," in
2 the County of Nassau, in the State of Florida, in accordance
3 with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate
4 the construction of bridges over navigable waters," ap-
5 proved March 23, 1906.

6 SEC. 2. The right to alter, amend, or repeal this Act
7 is hereby expressly reserved.
