AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the States of Alabama and Georgia, through their respective highway departments, to construct and maintain a bridge across the Chattahoochee River, at or near Alaga, Alabama, connecting Houston County, Alabama, and Early County, Georgia

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the States
4 of Alabama and Georgia, through their respective highway
5 departments, to construct and maintain a bridge and ap-
6 proaches thereto across the Chattahoochee River, at a
7 point suitable to the interests of navigation, at or near
8 Alaga, Alabama, connecting Houston County, Alabama,
9 and Early County, Georgia, in accordance with the pro-
10 visions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the con-
11 struction of bridges over navigable waters," approved
12 March 23, 1906.

1 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
2 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
