A BILL

To authorize the States of Alabama and Georgia, through their respective highway departments, to construct and maintain a bridge across the Chattahoochee River, at or near Alaga, Alabama, connecting Houston County, Alabama, and Early County, Georgia

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 *That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the States*
4 *of Alabama and Georgia, through their respective highway*
5 *departments, ~~be and are hereby, authorized~~ to construct and*
6 *maintain a bridge and approaches thereto across the Chatta-*
7 *hoochee River, at a point suitable to the interests of naviga-*
8 *tion, at or near Alaga, Alabama, connecting Houston*

1 County, Alabama, and Early County, Georgia, in accordance
2 with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate
3 the construction of bridges over navigable waters," approved
4 March 23, 1906.

5 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
6 Act is hereby expressly reserved.

Amend the title so as to read: "A bill granting the consent of Congress to the States of Alabama and Georgia, through their respective highway departments, to construct and maintain a bridge across the Chattahoochee River, at or near Alaga, Alabama, connecting Houston County, Alabama, and Early County, Georgia."
