# A BILL

To authorize the States of Alabama and Georgia, through their respective highway departments, to construct and maintain a bridge across the Chattahoochee River, at or near Alaga, Alabama, connecting Houston County, Alabama, and Early County, Georgia

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the States of Alabama and Georgia, through their  
4       respective highway departments, be and are hereby, au-  
5       thorized to construct and maintain a bridge and approaches  
6       thereto across the Chattahoochee River, at a point suitable  
7       to the interests of navigation, at or near Alaga, Alabama,  
8       connecting Houston County, Alabama, and Early County,  
9       Georgia, in accordance with the provisions of the Act en-

1 titled "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges over  
2 navigable waters," approved March 23, 1906.

3 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this  
4 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
