**AN ACT**

Granting the consent of Congress to the North Texas Company, of Saint Jo, Texas, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas, to construct a toll bridge across the Red River in the vicinity of Illinois Bend, Texas

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the North  
4 Texas Company, of Saint Jo, Texas, to construct a bridge  
5 across the Red River in the vicinity of Illinois Bend, Texas,  
6 under specifications complying with all laws, rules, and regu-  
7 lations governing such, and their successors and assigns, to  
8 construct, maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches  
9 thereto across the Red River at a point suitable to the  
10 interests of navigation, at or near Illinois Bend, Texas,  
11 in the county of Montague, in the State of Texas,  
12 in accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An

1 Act to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable  
2 waters," approved March 23, 1906.

3 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this  
4 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
