A BILL

Granting the consent of Congress to the Texas and Oklahoma Red River Bridge Company, Incorporated, of Saint Jo, Texas, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas, to construct a toll bridge across the Red River in the vicinity of Illinois Bend, Texas

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the Texas
4 and Oklahoma Red River Bridge Company, Incorporated, of
5 Saint Jo, Texas, to construct a toll bridge across the Red
6 River in the vicinity of Illinois Bend, Texas, under speci-
7 fications complying with all laws, rules, and regulations gov-
8 erning such, and their successors and assigns, to construct,

1 maintain, and operate a bridge and approaches thereto across
2 the Red River at a point suitable to the interests of naviga-
3 tion, at or near Illinois Bend, Texas, in the county of Mon-
4 tague, in the State of Texas, in accordance with the pro-
5 visions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the construc-
6 tion of bridges over navigable waters," approved March 23,
7 1906.

8 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
9 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
