AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the Chicago, Milwaukee and Saint Paul Railway Company to construct a bridge over the Mississippi River between Saint Paul and Minneapolis, Minnesota.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the Chi-
4 cago, Milwaukee and Saint Paul Railway Company, a cor-
5 poration organized under the laws of the State of Wisconsin,
6 its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain, and operate
7 a bridge and approaches thereto across the Mississippi River
8 so as to connect the line of railway of said company, in the
9 city of Saint Paul, with the railway of said company near
10 the south limits of the city of Minneapolis, at a location suit-

1 able to the interests of navigation, in accordance with the
2 provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the con-
3 struction of bridges over navigable waters," approved March
4 23, 1906.

5 . SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
6 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
