AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the State of Alabama, through its highway department, to construct and maintain a bridge across the Coosa River at or near Leesburg, Alabama.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the State
4 of Alabama, through its highway department, to construct
5 and maintain a bridge and approaches thereto across the
6 Coosa River, at a point suitable to the interests of navigation,
7 at or near Leesburg, Alabama, in accordance with the pro-
8 visions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the construc-
9 tion of bridges over navigable waters," approved March 23,
10 1906.

11 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
12 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
