## A BILL

To authorize the State of Alabama, through its highway department, to construct and maintain a bridge across the Coosa River, at or near Leesburg, Alabama, connecting Leesburg, Alabama, and Center, Alabama, on the primary road system of the State

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the State of Alabama, through its highway department,  
4        is hereby authorized to construct and maintain a bridge  
5        and approaches thereto across the Coosa River, at a point  
6        suitable to the interests of navigation, at or near Leesburg,  
7        Alabama, connecting Leesburg, Alabama, and Center, Ala-  
8        bama, on the primary road system of the State, in accord-

1   ance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to  
2   regulate the construction of bridges over navigable waters,"  
3   approved March 23, 1906.

4           SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this  
5   Act is hereby expressly reserved.
