
IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

DECEMBER 20, 1923.

Mr. JARRETT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Territories and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

To extend the provisions of certain laws to the Territory of Hawaii.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That beginning with the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925,
4 the Territory of Hawaii shall be entitled to share in appropri-
5 ations now or which may hereafter become available for
6 apportionment under the Act entitled "An Act to provide
7 that the United States shall aid the States in the construction
8 of rural post roads, and for other purposes," approved July
9 11, 1916, or the Federal Highway Act, or any Act amend-
10 atory thereof or supplementary thereto, upon the same terms
11 and conditions as any of the several States, and such Terri-
12 tory shall be included in the calculations to determine the
13 basis of apportionment of such funds: *Provided*, That in
14 approving road projects in such Territory to receive Federal

1 aid, the Secretary of Agriculture shall give preference to such
2 projects as will expedite the completion of an adequate sys-
3 tem of highways for the national defense or which will con-
4 nect seaports with units of the national parks.

5 SEC. 2. Subject to the approval of the Federal Farm
6 Loan Board and under such conditions as it may prescribe,
7 the provisions of the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended,
8 are extended to the Territory of Hawaii. Such board
9 shall include the Territory in a Federal land bank district,
10 and such Federal land bank as the board may designate
11 is authorized to establish branch banks in the Territory.

12 SEC. 3. The Territory of Hawaii shall be entitled to
13 share in the benefits of the Act entitled "An Act for the
14 promotion of the welfare and hygiene of maternity and
15 infancy, and for other purposes," approved November 23,
16 1921, or any Act amendatory thereof or supplementary
17 thereto, upon the same terms and conditions as any of the
18 several States. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925,
19 there is authorized to be appropriated, out of any money in
20 the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
21 \$13,000, to be available for apportionment under such
22 Act to the Territory, and annually thereafter such sum as
23 would be apportioned to the Territory if such Act had
24 originally included the Territory.

1 SEC. 4. The Territory of Hawaii shall be entitled to
2 share in the benefits of the Act entitled "An Act to provide
3 for the promotion of vocational education; to provide for
4 cooperation with the States in the promotion of such educa-
5 tion in agriculture and the trades and industries; to provide
6 for cooperation with the States in the preparation of teachers
7 of vocational subjects; and to appropriate money and regu-
8 late its expenditure," approved February 23, 1917, or any
9 Act amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto, upon
10 the same terms and conditions as any of the several States.
11 There is authorized to be appropriated, out of any money
12 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the fiscal
13 year ending June 30, 1925, and annually thereafter, the
14 sum of \$30,000, to be available for allotment under such Act
15 to the Territory.

16 SEC. 5. The Territory of Hawaii shall be entitled to
17 share in the benefits of the Act entitled "An Act to provide
18 for the promotion of vocational rehabilitation of persons dis-
19 abled in industry or otherwise and their return to civil em-
20 ployment," approved June 2, 1920, or any Act amendatory
21 thereof or supplementary thereto, upon the same terms and
22 conditions as any of the several States. There is authorized
23 to be appropriated, out of any money in the Treasury not
24 otherwise appropriated, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
25 1925, and annually thereafter, the sum of \$5,000, to be
26 available for allotment under such Act to the Territory.
