## AN ACT

To extend the provisions of certain laws to the Territory of Hawaii.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That beginning with the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925,  
4 the Territory of Hawaii shall be entitled to share in appro-  
5 priations now or which may hereafter become available for  
6 apportionment under the Act entitled "An Act to provide  
7 that the United States shall aid the States in the construc-  
8 tion of rural post roads, and for other purposes," approved  
9 July 11, 1916, ~~or known as the Federal Highway Act, or~~  
10 *and any Act amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto,*  
11 upon the same terms and conditions as any of the several

1 States, and such Territory shall be included in the calcula-  
2 tions to determine the basis of apportionment of such funds:  
3 *Provided*, That in approving road projects in such Territory  
4 to receive Federal aid, the Secretary of Agriculture shall  
5 give preference to such projects as will expedite the com-  
6 pletion of an adequate system of highways for the national  
7 defense or which will connect seaports with units of the  
8 national parks.

9 **SEC. 2.** Subject to the approval of the Federal Farm  
10 Loan Board and under such conditions as it may prescribe,  
11 the provisions of the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended,  
12 are extended to the Territory of Hawaii. Such board shall  
13 include the Territory in a Federal land bank district, and  
14 such Federal land bank as the board may designate is au-  
15 thorized to establish branch banks in the Territory.

16 *SEC. 2. The provisions of the Federal Farm Loan*  
17 *Act, and any Act amendatory thereof or supplementary*  
18 *thereto, are extended to the Territory of Hawaii. The*  
19 *Federal Farm Loan Board shall include the Territory in*  
20 *a Federal land bank district, and such Federal land bank*  
21 *as the board may designate is authorized to establish branch*  
22 *banks in the Territory.*

23 **SEC. 3.** The Territory of Hawaii shall be entitled to  
24 share in the benefits of the Act entitled "An Act for the  
25 promotion of the welfare and hygiene of maternity and

1 infancy, and for other purposes," approved November 23,  
2 1921, ~~or~~ *and* any Act amendatory thereof or supplementary  
3 thereto, upon the same terms and conditions as any of the  
4 several States. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1925,  
5 there is authorized to be appropriated, out of any money in  
6 the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$13,000,  
7 to be available for apportionment under such Act to the  
8 Territory, and annually thereafter such sum as would be  
9 apportioned to the Territory if such Act had originally in-  
10 cluded the Territory.

11       SEC. 4. The Territory of Hawaii shall be entitled to  
12 share in the benefits of the Act entitled "An Act to provide  
13 for the promotion of vocational education; to provide for  
14 cooperation with the States in the promotion of such educa-  
15 tion in agriculture and the trades and industries; to provide  
16 for cooperation with the States in the preparation of teachers  
17 of vocational subjects; and to appropriate money and regu-  
18 late its expenditure," approved February 23, 1917, ~~or~~ *and*  
19 any Act amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto, upon  
20 the same terms and conditions as any of the several States.  
21 There is authorized to be appropriated, out of any money  
22 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the  
23 fiscal year ending June 30, 1925, and annually thereafter,  
24 the sum of \$30,000, to be available for allotment under such  
25 Act to the Territory.

1        SEC. 5. The Territory of Hawaii shall be entitled to  
2 share in the benefits of the Act entitled "An Act to provide  
3 for the promotion of vocational rehabilitation of persons dis-  
4 abled in industry or otherwise and their return to civil em-  
5 ployment," approved June 2, 1920, ~~or~~ and any Act amend-  
6 atory thereof or supplementary thereto, upon the same terms  
7 and conditions as any of the several States. There is au-  
8 thorized to be appropriated, out of any money in the Treas-  
9 ury not otherwise appropriated, for the fiscal year ending  
10 June 30, 1925, and annually thereafter, the sum of \$5,000,  
11 to be available for allotment under such Act to the Territory.
