AN ACT

Granting the consent of Congress to the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge across the Columbia River.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the
4 Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District, a corporation organ-
5 ized and existing under the laws of the State of Washing-
6 ton, its successors, and assigns to construct, maintain, and
7 operate a bridge and approaches thereto across the Colum-
8 bia River, at a point suitable to the interests of navigation,
9 within or near section 15, in township 20 north, of range 23
10 east of Willamette meridian, in the State of Washington, in

1 accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act
2 to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable
3 waters," approved March 23, 1906.

4 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
5 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
