Mr. HILL of Washington introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce and ordered to be printed.

A BILL

Granting the consent of Congress to the Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge across the Columbia River.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the consent of Congress is hereby granted to the
4 Greater Wenatchee Irrigation District, a corporation organ-
5 ized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington,
6 its successors, and assigns, to construct, maintain, and oper-
7 ate a bridge and approaches thereto across the Columbia
8 River at a point suitable to the interests of navigation within
9 or near section 15, in township 20 north, of range 23 east,
10 of Willamette meridian, in the State of Washington, in ac-
11 cordance with the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act

1 to regulate the construction of bridges over navigable waters,"
2 approved March 23, 1906.

3 SEC. 2. That the right to alter, amend, or repeal this
4 Act is hereby expressly reserved.
