A BILL

Authorizing the city of Ludington, Mason County, Michigan, to construct a bridge across the Pere Marquette River.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That the city of Ludington, Mason County, Michigan, be,
- 4 and it is hereby, authorized to construct, maintain, and oper-
- 5 ate a bridge and approaches thereto across ~~the~~ *an arm of*
- 6 Pere Marquette ~~River~~ *Lake* at Washington Avenue in said
- 7 city, in accordance with the provisions of the Act entitled
- 8 "An Act to regulate the construction of bridges over naviga-
- 9 ble waters," approved March 23, 1906.

1 SEC. 2. The right to alter, amend, or repeal this Act is
2 hereby expressly reserved.
