A BILL

Authorizing the city of Ludington, Mason County, Michigan, to construct a bridge across the Pere Marquette River.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the city of Ludington, Mason County, Michigan, be, and
4 it is hereby, authorized to construct, maintain, and operate a
5 bridge and approaches thereto across the Pere Marquette
6 River at Washington Avenue in said city, in accordance with
7 the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to regulate the
8 construction of bridges over navigable waters," approved
9 March 23, 1906.

10 SEC. 2. The right to alter, amend, or repeal this Act is
11 hereby expressly reserved.
